Subject: Short Term Application Process (3 months to 2 years)

The application process moves an interested person from inquirer to deployed missionary while training and preparing the applicant for the mission field, as well as allowing mutual evaluation by ECMI-USA, the sending church, the leadership of the chosen country of service, and the applicant.

The major steps are:

- 1. Fill out Get Started form (10 min)
- 2. Interview within one week, with follow up interview(s) as needed to clear up questions, including any up-front costs and necessary support levels
- 3. Fill out application, with references (4 hours)
- 4. Get feedback from references, sending church, transcripts, and background checks (up to five weeks)
- 5. Visit the country where you will be ministering; meet the team (Nominally 2 weeks). *Generally this visit is only for candidates ministering from 1 to 2 years.*
- 6. Complete candidate orientation (one week, or 4-6 hours on-line)
- 7. Get training in support-raising (3 weeks) *Generally this is only for candidates ministering from 1 to 2 years.*
- 8. Raise support (from 3 to 65 weeks depending on the length of the mission)
- 9. Obtain necessary visa (nominally13 weeks)
- 10. Complete training in cross-cultural missions and language learning skills (4 weeks) *Generally this task is only for candidates ministering from 1 to 2 years.*
- 11. Complete all necessary administration and legal forms
- 12. Be commissioned by sending church
- 13. Depart for country of service when support level is 100%
